Dear Families of Immaculate Conception Parish School:

The following will help you prepare for the ending of the school year and the beginning of the upcoming school year:

- Morning Prayer will continue each school day at 8:10 am until Wednesday, June 17, 2020. The prayer is posted on IC Facebook and at the Website [icrevere.org](http://icrevere.org).
- Zoom Classes will end on Thursday, June 11<sup>th</sup> for 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Classes.
- The 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will come to Immaculate Conception School on Friday, June 12, 2020 at a specified scheduled time between 8:00 am and 11:00 am to pick up and drop off books.
- The 7<sup>th</sup> grade students will come to the school as well on Friday, June 12<sup>th</sup> at a specified scheduled time between 1:00 pm and 4:00 pm. 6<sup>th</sup> Grade families may check with Mr. Domina and 7<sup>th</sup> Grade families may check with Mr. Melchionno for any particular information about Friday, June 12<sup>th</sup>.
- When you drop off books or athletic uniforms, please place them in a plastic bag with the child's name on the bag. Athletic uniforms need to be in a separate plastic bag. The student must wear a mask to enter the school. The school will have hand sanitizer.
- Zoom classes will end on Friday, June 12, 2020 from Kindergarten to 5<sup>th</sup>
- **The pick-up and drop off day for 1<sup>st</sup> grade to 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will be on Monday, June 15<sup>th</sup> from 12:00 pm to 3:30 pm. It will be on a first come first serve basis. All vehicles head to the Church parking lot. Do not park on Lowe Street. IC staff will call the first five (5) families to drive their vehicles to Father Brennan Hall. You will pop your trunk or pop the rear door and an IC staff member will drop off your child's belongings in a plastic bag and pull out your child's returned books from the trunk. The returned books need to be in a plastic bag with a name tag and grade on the plastic bag.**
- The School Activities from Kindergarten to 7<sup>th</sup> Grade will continue Monday, June 15<sup>th</sup> through June 16<sup>th</sup>. A scheduled Art Slideshow and Music Show will be presented on the IC website.
